Replace with manufacturer spec battery 3. Test new battery 4. Report additional findings to customer**	\$20* + cost of battery + tax
Belt Replacement <21" Mowers	Self Propelled Mower	If your equipment belts are slipping, squealing, or your wheels are not turning. 1. Inspect belts for cracks, wear, & tension 2. Replace worn or broken belts with OEM-spec replacements 3. Check pulleys & tensioners for proper alignment 4. Test run & adjustment 5. Report additional findings to customer **	\$30* + cost of belt + tax
Belt Replacement >21" Mowers	Riding Mower, Commercial/Zero Turn Mower	If your equipment belts are slipping, squealing, or blades won't engage. 1. Inspect belts for cracks, wear, & tension 2. Replace worn or broken belts with OEM-spec replacements 3. Check pulleys & tensioners for proper alignment 4. Test run & adjustment 5. Report additional findings to customer **	\$60 - \$90* (price is dependent on equipment type) + cost of belt + tax
Blade Sharpening	Lawn Mower, Edger, Weed Eater, Hedge Trimmer	If your lawn looks uneven, grass tips are frayed, or mowing takes longer than it should. 1. Inspect blade 2. Sharpen 3. Balance & adjust 4. Report additional findings to customer**	\$10/blade* + \$5/blade for removal + tax

Verify oil level & check for leaks 5. Report additional findings to customer **	\$65* + tax (covers up to 64 oz of oil, additional oil will be billed to customer)
Oil Change	Commercial Zero Turn / Large Riding Mowers	Change annually or every 50-100 hours, whichever comes first. 1. Drainage and disposal of old oil 2. Refill with new oil per manufacturer specs 3. Replace filter 4. Verify oil level & check for leaks 5.
